


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A statement on Diversity, Equity & Inclusion (DEI)

Each individual matters in my classes regardless of religion, sexuality, class, gender, or race. DEI matters in this class for many reasons. I will outline two. First, humans have an arduous journey ahead of us toward a healthy, happy, sustainable, prosperous, peaceful planet for everyone. For everyone. People exactly like you are vital to this process. So are a large number of people who are not like you at all.



If we do not include, employ, reward, and respect all talent, we will make more noise than music, more heat than light, more chaos than progress. No one wants to live in noisy, dark and chaotic places.



How do I know this? Simple. From human history. Some 200,000 years ago, grass bedding with insect repellant herbs was a major invention of humans. If the person who knew about grass, stayed with other people who knew about grass; if the grass and bedding person did not want to include the herbalist with insights into insect repellant, and if each did not



benefit equitably from the collaboration – you and I would sleep on stone and face perforation by insects.

No one wants to sleep on stone while perforated by insects.

A DEI denying species leaves behind a trail of bits and bobs such as plastic in oceans, dioxin in air, lead in water, hate and discord on the airwaves and neglect and strife on the ground. Without dedication to DEI, we make for a very dull, silly species. Dull, silly species fight with each other and eventually go extinct.
